## What to expect

- **Cheetah Reintroduction Landscape:** Witness the remarkable reintroduction of cheetahs at Kuno National Park, marking the world's first intercontinental translocation of big cat.
- **Rich & Diverse Wildlife:** Beyond cheetahs, the park is home to leopards, striped hyenas, wolves, jackals, nilgai, chinkara, deer species, and over 200 varieties of birds thriving in a protected natural ecosystem.
- **Unique Landscape & Geography:** Spread across the Vindhyan hills and riverine forests of central India, Kuno offers a striking mix of grasslands, dry deciduous forests, rocky terrains, and the scenic Kuno River basin.
- **Gateway via Historic Gwalior:** Conveniently connected to the heritage city of Gwalior, renowned for its majestic forts, royal palaces, classical music legacy, and rich cultural history.

## How to reach

**Distance by road:** 428 km from New Delhi

**Nearest Airport-** Gwalior Airport

**Distance from nearest airport:** 200 km

\*Travel by air will require transfer from the airport to the site via taxi



## Tentative cost

**Travel to-and-from New Delhi** Air- INR 5000-7000 (USD 52-75)  
Road- INR 10,000-15,000 (USD 105-160)

**Stay** INR 5,000-8,000 (USD 52-85)

**Safari** Gate Permit (per person)- INR 825 (USD 9)  
Guide charges - INR 800 (USD 8.5)  
Gypsy charges (pickup at gate - safari - drop at gate) - INR 2500 (USD 27)
